

Capital Field Archers Branch Shoot Waste Disposal Plan

Purpose

To define standard practice for the disposal of additional waste material resulting from the annual CFA Branch Shoot.

Background

As part of its association with the national archery organization ABA, Capital Field Archers (CFA) hosts an annual Branch shoot inviting other NSW clubs to compete. The event is held over a weekend, with participants typically arriving Friday Night and camping on-site until the following Sunday or Monday. Normally attendees will take the bulk of their waste with then when they go, however some will also utilize the recycle and general waste bins provided by CFA.

Waste Management and Disposal

The CFA clubhouse maintains separate waste bins for Recyclable and General waste products. For the Annual Branch Shoot CFA will also provide an enclosed box trailer for any additional bagged waste that attendees may produce over the weekend.

As part of the final cleanup and teardown for the event the clubhouse and camping areas will be checked for and cleared of any remaining rubbish. The club Recycle and General waste bins will then be cleared and taken to the nearest ACT waste facility along with any bagged rubbish from the box trailer.
