



COVID-19 SAFETY

CFA has adopted the following COVID-19 mitigation strategies to minimize the risk to virus transmission between attendees.

The following rules are mandatory and failure to comply will result in your immediate removal from this site.

Australian Government COVID-19 directives

- Outdoor gatherings are limited in accordance with current Government COVID-19 policy.
- Members will observe the required minimum social distancing of 1.5 metres at all times.
- Members will practice frequent hand hygiene (20 seconds soap & water / hand sanitizer).
- Members will practice respiratory hygiene (cover nose and mouth when coughing/sneezing, avoid touching face).
- Members will stay home if unwell or in high risk categories.
- Members exhibiting any of the following symptoms: cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, shall get tested.

ABA National Executive COVID-19 Recommendations

- Archers are to use their own equipment. No borrowing unless from the same household.
- Archers are to pull their own arrows unless from the same household.
- Shoot groups are not to move to the next target until it has been vacated by the preceding group.
- CFA will provide a suitable handwashing station at site.
- Club equipment is to be cleaned/disinfected after each person's use.
- No physical contact during greetings (no handshakes / hugs).
- Communal areas / toilet facilities / common equipment must be cleaned at regular intervals.
- Food / water / drink bottles are not to be shared.

CFA Specific COVID-19 Directives

- Members identified as carrying the COVID-19 virus must inform the CFA Committee immediately.
- Members are required to register their attendance at each CFA event.
- Member registration must occur immediately upon arrival, and just prior departure.
- One CFA member will be assigned to update the attendance register for all members (to avoid sharing pens).
- CFA COVID-19 warnings will be included in the pre-activity briefing.
- CFA COVID-19 requirements will be distributed to all CFA members (this document).
- Members in a high-risk medical category are not to attend CFA activities at this time.
- Members refusing to comply with the posted COVID-19 directives will not be permitted on site.

CFA Specific COVID-19 Recommendations
